- To create awareness about gender discrimination. To spread the knowledge about equal opportunities available for women in the society.
- To make women aware about the rights and legal issues in order to fulfill the needs of women empowerment.

The context


- Female literacy rate is lower in education in the region. Literacy rate of female in Dibrugarh district 66.69% according to the Census 2011.
- Lack of sufficient higher education opportunities and social independence are major reasons which lead to problems relating to the safety of girls, social discrimination, sexual harassment etc.
- Keeping it in view, the demand of higher educational Institutions of the district, the college tries to every possible opportunity to maintain gender equality in the college.

Practices

To fulfil the objectives, various programmes, - Talks, Discussions and Seminars etc. have been organized from time to time.

Safety and Security:

1. The College has constituted the Disciplinary Committee so as to maintain and provide safety and security to all the stakeholders. All students of the college, particularly the female students are made aware of this committee and are advised to approach it in any case of distress/ anguish.
2. ID cards and college uniform are mandatory to enter the college campus.
3. Parking facility is separated for male and female students.


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4. All corridors, classrooms and a few strategic locations come under the surveillance of CCTV cameras.
5. The college has an Anti-Ragging Committee and the ICC Cell to ensure violence and discrimination free environment in the college.
6. The College Girls' Hostel is equipped with full security and power backup.
7. Since the inception of this college is very strict to curb ragging and to promote anti-ragging activities.
8. The college provides common room for both girls' students and boys' students with separate toilets.

Counselling:


1. The college has a student counselling cell. Regular counselling is done to assess the students as and when necessary. Emphasis has been given on psychological counselling by inviting experts, to the female students who reside in the hostel.
2. Number of lecture programmes/ seminars have been organised by the women cell to aware the laws regarding violence against women, women empowerment and gender equity.
3. Women cell of the college in Association with NCC unit conducted occasional Self defence programs for the girl students.
4. During the last five years, various guest lectures have been organised on issues of gender sensitivity in which various invited eminent personalities deliberately give their lectures.
5. World Women's Day is celebrated to carry out various activities to sensitize students every year by showing movies on women issues, HIV, social evils etc.
6. To expand the Gender equity initiative beyond the campus, a 'Women Literacy Programme' has been undertaken in one of the adopted villages.
7. Female teachers are encouraged to carry out more research activities on women issues.

Programmes Organized:

- 'International Girl Child Day' was observed on 11th Oct, 2017 by Women's Cell, Nandalal Borgohain City College at "Prerana Children Home," Dibrugarh. The College has donated some essential material such as Pen, Pencils, books, food, etc.
- "World Environment Day" was celebrated on 5th June, 2018. Women Cell organised an awareness programme related with this occasion. On the 44th World Environment Day a procession of teacher and students was initiated and the procession covered near by the College areas.

- To maintain a smooth academic environment.


Blood Donation Camp:

Context:

- Shortage of blood in the blood banks for needy people is a very serious problem in our society.
- The college arranges blood donation camps in association with blood bank of AMC.
- The camps are initiatives of NCC and NSS wing to create awareness among the people and encourage more and more students to donate blood for noble cause.

PRACTICES:

- The NCC and NSS wing of the institution believes in undertaking extension activities to build up community and to help the under-privileged category through educational support, legal awareness camps, blood donation camp programme.
- Cleanliness Activity Awareness Programme: IQAC proposed cleanliness drive in different phases like campus cleaning and beyond campus as a part of the best practice of college in order to create awareness among people.
- Medicinal Plants are planted in the campus and surrounding areas of the college.
- Cleanliness Drives:

 - Adaption of village for holistic development.



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WASTE MANAGEMENT

- **Solid Waste Management:** Solid waste generated from the college campus is handled in a variety of ways. Solid waste are first categorized based on materials such as paper, plastic, glass, metal and organic waste. Solid waste disposal are managed video systematically in the college campus by installing of the colored waste bins:
 1. **Green bins-** for biodegradable waste, e.g. fallen leaves of plants and papers.
 2. **Blue bins/ Yellow bins/ Red bins-**for non biodegradable waste, e.g. (B) plastic, (Y) glass, (R) metals respectively. Sometimes solid waste like paper, plant leaves, are burned in the open space of college campus on holidays and non- biodegradable waste like plastic, glass, metal generated from the college and periodically collected by the municipality.

Disposal of Organic Waste: Organic waste is disposed in the college campus in a newly constructed warm farm composting unit. (Procedure is annexed with other additional information)

- **Liquid Waste Management:** The waste water is drained out into its neighboring municipality drains and wet lands.


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
